1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report details the tenders received for the supply delivery and installation of gallery seating and the removal of the old seating in the Caird Hall, and requests approval to accept the lowest tender.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Approval is recommended for the acceptance of the tender submitted by a company called Audience Seating at a cost of £48,450.00

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 This expenditure can be met from the Leisure and Communities Department's 2009/10 Capital Budget.

4.0 TENDER REPORT

- 4.1 The current gallery seating was to be replaced during the 2002 refurbishment. However, due to financial constraints this did not take place. With the high profile events which are now taking place in the venue and the ever increasing cost of tickets and customers increased expectations, complaints are being received with regards to the lack of quality of the gallery seating. The current seating has been installed for over 25 years.
- 4.2 There are a limited number of suppliers with the expertise and experience in this field. The seating specification is to match the existing auditorium seating. Three tenders were submitted as detailed below.

4.3 The tenders were evaluated using a pre-determined list of criteria. The recommended contractor's bid matches all the essential criteria to a satisfactory level and is the lowest submitted.
