1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the request to introduce a 20mph trial zone for lengths of road in The Glens area of Dundee following a citywide consultation: Report 385-2016: 20mph Speed Limits Consultation which was discussed at Committee on 12 December 2016 (Article VIII refers)..

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 The Committee is asked to approve the preparation of the trial Traffic Regulation Order to introduce a 20mph zone within the residential area known as The Glens.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Order, erecting speed limit signage and painting roundels will be met by current City Development budgets.

4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 As part of the city-wide consultation The Glens area of Dundee was selected as a trial area for a 20mph zone following a high response rate from local residents.
