6 BACKGROUND

The background claims information provided herein contain the following factors.

- a Skewing of value in 2001/2002 due to the impact of the fire at TDI factory;
- b remarkable stability (against a national trend of increase) in many of the classes of cover in respect of claims intimated; and
- c a significant (20%) reduction in the volume of Property claims evidence of the success of previous risk management expenditure designed to lessen malicious damage in particular.

7 CONCLUSION

The monitoring of claims experience will continue to be used as a means to direct risk management activity.
