1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the necessity to stop-up a length of the Honeygreen Road and Afton Place.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 Planning consent has been granted to develop the site of the former Linlathen High School for a supermarket. Committee is now asked to approve the preparation of a Stopping-Up Order utilising the powers of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 to stop-up a length of Honeygreen Road and Afton Place in order to facilitate the new development.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by the developer.

4 SUSTAINABILITY POLICY IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The redevelopment of the former school site gives the opportunity to enhance the local environs through ongoing regeneration.

5.1 Access to shopping will be available to all.

6 BACKGROUND

- 6.1 In order to accommodate a new supermarket development on the site of the former Linlathen High School it is necessary to stop-up those lengths of road as indicated on the attached plan.
- 6.2 A planning application has been approved to construct this new development.
- A new access road will be provided accessing the development and will include a link to Honeygreen Road.
- 6.4 The remaining property in Afton Place will be demolished as part of the development. Afton Place will no longer serve any frontages following the demolition and consequently can be Stopped-Up.
