- 3.2 An allowance of £375,000.00 was originally made for this project in Report 248/2000 including annual surfacing repairs. The original proposals have now been extended to include additional features including new apron floodlights, a helicopter pad, an aircraft refuelling area and associated petrol interceptors and environmental drainage system. These additional features together with a rise in the cost of bituminous pavement materials, related to the world price of crude oil, have increased the project cost to £560,000.00
