1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report seeks approval to stop-up lengths of road and footways in Craigowl Road utilising the powers of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 to enable development following planning consent for the change of use from public road and footway to an enclosed compound for industrial buildings.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the promotion of a Stopping-up Order for sections of Craigowl Road.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by the developer.

4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Following planning approval to close off Craigowl Road and consolidate a business into one enclosed site on the aforementioned area it will be necessary to stop-up lengths of road and footways. The lengths of road and footways on the attached plan will require to be stopped up and removed from the List of Public Roads.


