1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek approval to award a grant to Royal Scottish National Orchestra towards the cost of developing music initiatives in the community.

- Royal Scottish National Orchestra will perform a total of nine concerts at the Caird Hall. In addition, there will be a performance at the Caird Hall on Wednesday 28 November on new work commissioned by the orchestra from Graham Fitkin as the culmination of their work in Dundee schools over the past three years as part of the Dundee Music Plus Project.
- 6.2 Current work in Dundee also includes:
 - Community Projects: two visits by RSNO musicians to Ardler Neighbourhood Community Centre; The Mackinnon Centre; Ormiston Community Lounge; Whitfield Activity Complex; Barnardos Family Support Unit and Charleston Community Centre.
 - Fitkin Project: the Fitkin Project will involve pupils from Baldragon Academy, Menzieshill High School, Brackens Primary and Glebelands Primary.
 - Scottish Power Schools Prom: over 1600 primary school children attended the Scottish Power Schools Prom concert at the Caird Hall on Thursday 14 June.
