# 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To seek approval from the Committee to undertake signage and improvements to the entrances of Dawson Park and Caird Park and the provision of information boards at Broughty Ferry Harbour and Castle Approach.

#### 2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 It is recommended that the committee approve the offer from T&N Gilmartin for improvement works to Dawson Park and Caird Park of £16,248.
- 2.2 The committee approve the offer from Forbes & Company Signmakers for information boards to Broughty Ferry Harbour and Castle Approach of £4,688.

### 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The total cost of £20,936 can be met from provision in the 2003/2004 Leisure and Arts Department Capital Budget.

#### 6.0 MAIN TEXT

6.1 The proposed refurbishment works and signage to the entrance of Dawson Park are designed to provide a welcoming and informative and user friendly first impression to the park. This is seen as the second phase of a programme of works to make improvements to the city's parks. Replacement railings, gates and fences are proposed along with new railings and low walls and signage. Each entrance at Dawson Park will have a map with signage delineating the zones for dog exercise. Caird Park will have new entrance signage.

Broughty Ferry Harbour and Castle Approach will be have information boards with the provision of space for Management Rules, notices for events and a plan of facilities along

the seafront, including small craft restriction zones in connection with the application for the 'Yellow Flag Award'.
