1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

To seek approval to carry out improvement works to the Otter Enclosure at Camperdown Country Park, Wildlife Centre.

2 **RECOMMENDATION**

2.1 It is recommended that the offer received from T & N Gilmartin to carry out the improvement works amounting to £19,954.30, including contingencies, be accepted.

6 MAIN TEXT

- 6.1 The proposed works include the erection of a water feature and new fence partitions.
- 6.2 The work is necessary because of the need to constantly refill the existing pond with water which disturbs the otters and the public's enjoyment of them.

The work includes the development of a stream and pool and splitting the enclosure in two with a chainlink fence to facilitate the breeding of the otters, and to provide more play opportunities for them. All work will be carried out in a sympathetic manner to the location.
