1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To authorise the purchase of two 7.5 tonne tippers which are to be used within the special collection services of the Waste Management Department.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the committee agree:

- (i) to accept the offer from Logan Inglis Limited for the supply of two Logan Inglis/Isuzu tippers amounting to £65,018.
- (ii) to note that the vehicles are being procured via the Authorities Buying Consortium (ABC) Heavy Vehicle Framework contract.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The total cost of the two vehicles is £65,018. Provision for this expenditure has been made in the Waste Management Department's Capital Budget for 2008/09.

4.1 The two vehicles recommended for purchase will replace two existing vehicles which have reached the end of their economic life.
