1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the necessity to stop-up the Drumlanrig Drive to Longcroft Road footpath.

2 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

2.1 The Committee is asked to approve the preparation of a Stopping-Up Order under the powers of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 to stop-up the entire length of the Drumlanrig Drive – Longcroft Road footpath to allow for the redevelopment of a derelict site and commence the formal consultation process.

6 BACKGROUND

- 6.1 Planning consent has been granted for Phase 4(b) of the Mid Craigie development. This consists of the construction of new housing on what is currently a derelict site.
- 6.2 Part of this development will be on that area of land bounded by Drumlanrig Drive, Inglefield Street and Longcroft Road. Within this area is a footpath from Drumlanrig Drive from a point opposite Mauchline Avenue northwards to Longcroft Road.
- 6.3 It will be necessary to stop-up this footpath depicted on the attached plan to allow the development to proceed. An alternative pedestrian route is nearby.
- 6.4 It was proposed to stop-up the footpath as part of an earlier phase of the development. Due to technical difficulties, however, the Order was withdrawn at that time.
- 6.5 This part of the development requires the footpath to be removed.
