- 4.2 In relation to the 2016/17 Audit plan, items D01-17 to D04-17 relate to standard internal audit activity throughout 2016/17 and are noted as complete. The proposed post implementation review of Due Diligence has been removed from the plan as it is regarded as not providing any added value to the previous Due Diligence review.
