

1 SCOTTISH URBAN REGENERATION FORUM AWARD - BROOKSBANK CENTRE AND SERVICES (AN5-2009)

Brooksbank Centre and Services was established earlier this year as a new project which integrates the services formerly provided by the Dundee Money Advice Support Team, Kiddie Kare and Brooksbank Centre.

The project is supported by the Fairer Scotland Fund and is managed by local residents from Mid Craige and Linlathen and its surrounding areas. Like all Fairer Scotland Fund projects, Brooksbank is currently operating under a Service Level Agreement and is well on its way to meeting its targets.

The Brooksbank project is going from strength to strength and on Thursday, 4th December, 2008, the project won the Scottish Urban Regeneration Forum Award in the "Partnerships Category", one of three top awards for Regeneration in Scotland.
