- 1 Living Gateway – Embraces nature by enveloping a tree and incorporating bird and beastie boxes. Framing the street as a destination, while offering a multi-cultural 'Welcome Wall'. Repeated zig-zag forms reference the trusswork of Dundee's former industrial mill buildings.
 - 2 Peoples' Parklets – Pockets of green space peppered around the street where deep planting space is available. Planting choices are sensory and interactive.
 - 3 Socket System – A series of 'plug-in points' laid out in a two-meter grid pattern to offer adaptability of use for the street in terms of lighting, artwork, etc.
 - 4 Boundary Banding – Corduroy tactile edging indicating the change between the shared path and the pedestrian only areas.
 - 5 Pavement Edging – Delineator strip to define edge of the historical pavement width.
 - 6 Woven Character Cassies – Graphic hard landscaping language of the city inspired by the woven patterns of Dundee and utilising local Angus sandstone, as a nod to those who came through the street before.
 - 7 Pedestrian Crossings – Defined passages to allow for crossing the central shared pathway, including tactile indicators.
 - 8 Tactile Blister Paving – To help designate pedestrian crossings points and navigate visually impaired users.
 - 9 Street Storylines – Referencing the elevational language to tell of its historical past while helping characterise and define areas of the street.
 - 10 Light Lines – SHUFFLE system, modular lighting system, including 360 LGT GEN 2 modules built from high-pressure die-cast aluminium combined with a clear, semi or totally sanded protectors to meet all lighting requirements.
LR GEN2 – Light ring integrating a wide range of colours, connecting people with environment & SHUFFLE 180 LGT enhancing lighting by directing lights towards a specific surrounding area.
 - 11 Slanters – A hybrid of a seat and planter, offering a range of seating and planter heights, and the inclusion of seating armrests, for accessibility.
 - 12 Loading Bays – Temporary parking spots for vehicles permitted to stop for the likes of deliveries, pick-ups and waste collection.
 - 13 City Stories – Brass plaques highlighting the creative community co-design input into the development of the street.
 - 14 Cycle Stations – Racks for storing bicycles including e-bike charger points.
 - 15 Social Stage – A focal point in which to gather, socialise, and perform. Includes a small stage and seating, a roof to provide shelter, and a shimmering backdrop inspired by reflective elements from around the city such as the River Tay.
 - 16 Flexi-Frames – Adaptable frameworks from which to hang artwork and banners in order to create a street gallery. Works within the Socket System to be moveable around the streetscape.
 - 17 Public Litter Bin – Housed in a bespoke timber and metal enclosure to tie in with the new visual language of the street.
 - 18 Residents' Recycling & Waste Bins – Enclosed in an aesthetically pleasing structure to compliment and blend in with the new streetscape.
