DUNDEE CITY COUNCIL (DOOF) (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2025

DUNDEE CITY COUNCIL, make the following order in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11(1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") and of all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 11(2), Dundee City Council have consulted the Dundee Local Access Forum and other persons they consider appropriate, given public notice of the intended purpose and effect of the Order, and considered any objections and representations made to them.

- 1. This Order may be cited as "Dundee City Council (Doof) (Exemption) Order 2025" and comes into effect at 00.01hrs on 27June 2025 and will expire at 23.59hrs on 11 July 2025 inclusive.
- 2. The effect of the Order is to exempt the Main event construction and concert site, including a section of Core Path 45, known as Queen Mother's Drive at Camperdown Park, Dundee indicated by a solid red line within the Event Main Construction site coloured green on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act.
- 3. The purposes for which the Order is made are providing for public safety and security during the construction and deconstruction of the Doof event infrastructure including temporary stages and buildings, and during the event itself.

The foregoing Order consisting of this page together with the plan annexed are signed on behalf of Dundee City Council by Head of Environment, Neighbourhood Services at Dundee on the 9th day of June two thousand and twenty-five.
