



## Walking

If you're arriving on foot, please refer to the map to locate both existing and newly designated safe crossing points, including at the main entrance to the campus. We've also highlighted footbridges over the Dighty Burn. To enhance safety, additional lighting has been installed along the south east sections of the Dighty path.



## Park and Stride

If you're driving to the campus during school hours, please consider parking slightly away from the campus and walking in the last few minutes. While on-site parking is available, Park and Stride helps reduce traffic congestion around the campus, supports a healthier lifestyle, and contributes to a cleaner air environment. There are several convenient locations within a 10-minute walk of the campus that are ideal for Park and Stride. Please park responsibly.



## Cycling & Wheeling

If travelling by bike or scooter, the campus has a large offering of sheltered and secure cycle parking for all visitors - near the main entrance. There is also cycle parking on offer to better protect property.



## Public Transport

Drumgeith Community Campus is well-served by several local bus routes operated by Xplore Dundee, providing convenient access for visitors. Key services include:

**Services 10 and 17** - These buses stop directly opposite the main campus entrance.

**Services 28 and 33** - These routes pass nearby, offering additional access with a short journey to the campus.

**Moffat & Williamson Service 88** also offers options during the day.

All service running times have been included within this leaflet, along with QR codes providing access to journey planners, bus ticketing information & service information.

### Free Bus Travel

If you're under 22, over 60 or have a disability, you can travel on any bus for free using your Young Scot / NEC card. Need help setting it up? Just scan the QR code overleaf. Everyone else can buy tickets through the Xplore Dundee app or on the bus.
