

Welcome to Eastern Cemetery

Eastern Cemetery, formerly known as Eastern Necropolis, was opened in 1863.

Both the layout of the original cemetery, and the striking architectural gates opposite Dalgleish Road which display the coat of arms of the Burgh of Dundee, were designed by William Scott.

With extensions to the North and East, it is still a working cemetery, so please be aware of machinery and respectful of funeral ceremonies.

As well as the impressive older memorials, there are many fine trees and shrub specimens to be seen along the meandering pathways.
