Mel updated the members on the discussion at the first CVG meeting. Lots of the same issues coming up – anti-social behaviour etc. A copy of the minute from the CVG meeting will be emailed out to all members of the LCPP.

What Matters to You – Hosting conversation cafe – 12<sup>th</sup> September, Kirkton Community Centre at 9:30am. Opportunity for community members to come together with council officers, elected members etc... Theme will be support for children and young people. ADP Working Group – meeting held last week of the Strathmartine ADP working group. Kirkton Local Management Group received funding for a Resilience group – supporting 10 people. Additional evening café in Kirkton Com Centre also funded. Football drop in DCT funded for St Paul's. Dundee West funded for football drop in Kirkton. Sidlaw View SFDW funded to work with parents. Group will meet prior to each LCPP to share practice and provide support. Focus on recovery and prevention, all projects above are funded through the Strathmartine LCPP allocation of monies from the Alcohol & Drugs partnership. Action - Link Jemma Kiernan in with group to support Planet Youth link ups Community Safety – Halloween / Bonfire Night – Reflection on the previous work and success of PSYV event for young people in the area, football event etc... focus on family engagement. Meeting tomorrow of Community Safety & Justice group to start discussions about the plans for this year. Community event planning underway but bigger!

#### Priority Area 1

- We need to improve spaces, places and transportation in Strathmartine to better meet the needs of the community.
  - Connecting green spaces or routes to encourage people to use the provisions in place Active Travel Routes needs to be better connected
  - Ongoing projects Keswick, Community Gardens

## Priority Area 2

- We need to improve local supports for people around mental health and recovery.
  - ADP funding to support projects
  - Primary Prevention Planet Youth
  - Mens Groups
  - Felt that health is missing from the supports on offer consider linking with GP, Sarah to link Mark with Public Health colleagues, need for more outreach?

## Priority Area 3

- We need to target support for families and children in need across Strathmartine to improve life chances.
  - Need for more family provision rather than splitting children, young people and their parents.
  - Continue to roll out What Matters To You across Strathmartine.
  - Consideration for further opportunities to increase provision for children, young people and families.
  - How can Planet Youth risk and protective factors be fed into this to celebrate the good work already happening

Agreed to continue discussing and agreeing actions at the next LCPP in November.
