We have also included some suggested park and stride locations, as we know not everyone can walk, wheel, or cycle the whole way to school. When parking and striding, please ensure that your vehicle has been parked in a safe location, taking care to ensure local residents are not impacted negatively by your actions. By parking and striding, we can keep the school environment free of vehicles and safer for the school community.

Tayview Primary School has cycle and scooter parking making it easier for you to cycle and wheel to school.

Designated School Crossing Patrols are shown on your map. From time to time, designated crossings may not be manned. If any crossing point is likely to be without a patrol for an extended period, your school will let you know.


