

The following document defines in detail each indicator and related targets outlined within the 2017 City Plan.

- A link to the source of data is provided along with related dates of publication and contact details.
- To facilitate the process of confident and ambitious target setting within the City Plan trend data was obtained for each indicator (if available) for Dundee, Scotland and other local authorities in Scotland referred to as family groups (see below for family group definition).
- In some cases no trend or benchmarking data is available.
- Where a reference is given to family groups, this term is used within the Local Government Benchmarking Framework. Family groups based on factors such as population density and deprivation were agreed to provide a structure for similar councils to come together to drill-down into the benchmarking data. These groupings allow councils facing similar challenges to share good practice and work together to improve their services.


