

16 Days of Activism Against All Forms of Gender-based Violence

Every year, the Dundee Violence Against Women Partnership (DVAWP) are working closely together to deliver a number of awareness raising events as part of the International 16 Days campaign against all forms of gender based violence. This annual international campaign takes place from the 25th November (International Day of No Violence Against Women) to the 10th December (International Human Rights Day).

The theme for this year's international campaign is "**End Gender-Based Violence in the World of Work.**" It aims to continue to target the institutions in which gender-based violence is perpetuated and push for systemic change and accountability.

As part of this campaign, a variety of events will be delivered in Dundee to both the general public and professionals, including a **Reclaim the Night march**, a performance exploring the issues of **Coercive Control**, a Social Media campaign and training on **Harmful Practices**. These events will focus on raising awareness about all forms of violence against women and children, and touch on broader gender-based violence issues.
