

Launch of the Introduction to Good Governance Programme



Following the ongoing success of the Good Governance Award, a new foundation governance programme for small charities is being launched on 5 September.

The Introduction to Good Governance Programme (IGGP) will support small charities to strengthen their core governance. Participating charities will compile an assessed evidence eportfolio demonstrating competence in 12 criteria essential to all well run charities. Charities receive guidance and support, as well as access to online resources, to help them analyse and improve their governance practices.

Any Scottish charity is eligible to register for the programme, but it will be particularly beneficial for very small charities with few or no employees, or a turnover of less than £100,000 per year.
