C1814	Rockwell Girls Group	Coldside	To fund equipment and resources for a ten week project with four looked after young people interested in developing skills in makeup and nail art. The course will prepare the young people for a career in the beauty industry, they will work towards Dynamic Youth Awards, and all will have the opportunity to attend a hair and beauty taster course at college.	£576
CY1807	Kingspark School Parent Association	Coldside	To redevelop unused space in the school grounds into a nomadic landscape complete with natural sensory resources and a Yurt. This area would be a completely accessible space to play and develop skills and bookable for community use. The whole Kingspark community will benefit from this.	£3,133
EE1819	Dighty Connect	East End	To fund the production of a nature storybook addressing the issue of bullying, which will be used as a discussion tool within schools / youth groups, and outdoor workshops along the Dighty. This will benefit 300 children within the East End Ward.	£3,420
F1804	School and Family Development Worker	Ferry	To purchase resources to use when working with children and families who are identified as in need of social and emotional support. 200 young people are expected to benefit from these resources.	£700
F1808	Broughty Ferry YMCA	Ferry	To fund installation of a wheelchair accessible path along the lane which bounds YMCA premises, for the whole community to have better access to the facility and the newly improved gardens.	£2,450
F1809	Rotary Club of Broughty ferry	Ferry	To install a community access defibrillator at Castle Green in a secure container, operated by keypad that will be accessible to the whole community.	£1,575
F1810	Barnhill St Margaret's Church	Ferry	To purchase, install and commission a community access defibrillator and the provision of consumable materials associated with that, for use by the whole community.	£2,264

F1811	Grove Academy Eco Group	Ferry	To install a circular bench around an existing tree, refurbish a gifted rowing boat into a bug hotel, and to commission a wood sculpture to commemorate the significant history of the fishing industry in the Ferry at Sheill Street Community Garden.	£700
F1812	Active Schools Network	Ferry	To provide free activities for pupils from all three cluster primary schools who experience barriers to participation. This will allow engagement in sporting activities that would normally be inaccessible to them, promote healthy lifestyles, increase the quality and range of activities offered in school, and develop pathways from school to sports clubs for 70 pupils.	£630
L1831	Menzieshill Parish Church	Lochee	To promote the wide range of groups and projects available within the Menzieshill area through the delivery of a "What's On" magazine to the whole community, as well as publishing an online version. The grant will fund printing, delivery and web hosting.	£1,347
L1832	Charleston Community Centre LMG	Lochee	The Management Group are hosting a Burns Night Ceilidh. The evening will consist of live music and food. Tickets will cost £5 per person but food will be free. 80 people are expected to benefit.	£550
LP1801	City Development	Lochee	The old Lochee Clock was put into storage during the regeneration of the High Street 10 years ago. It was later found to be broken beyond repair. After community consultation a new clock will now be erected for the local community, who see the Lochee Clock as a local landmark.	£6,498
MP1803	Stobswell Forum	Maryfield	Contribution of funding towards door entry systems for four tenement blocks, 24 properties in total, on the south side of Dundonald Street to reduce issues of anti-social behaviour. Landlords, the Private Sector Unit and Housing Associations will also contribute by means of grants, monies towards projects and other works such as skips, clearing up of gardens, and fixing broken windows.	£10,720
WE1808	Friends of Balgay Park	West End	To enhance the improvements made to the Balgay Park Bandstand, this grant will fund the installation of 2 handrails, 2 small benches and 1 bespoke bench to the area for use by the whole community.	£4,032
