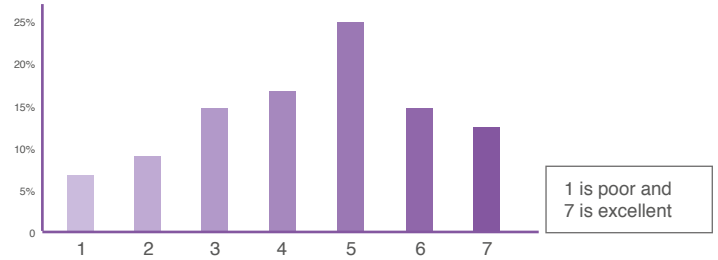


**Engage Dundee 2021** was an opportunity for the people of Dundee to tell us about what is important to them. We asked about five aspects of community life in their area; **Community Living, Community Travel, Community Spaces, Community Spirit and Community Support.**

The total respondents across the City was **825** respondents, **88** from East End.

The results below will be used to help inform Local Community Plans, Participatory Budgeting projects and local action across the area.

## Do you agree with these statements about Community Living in your area?



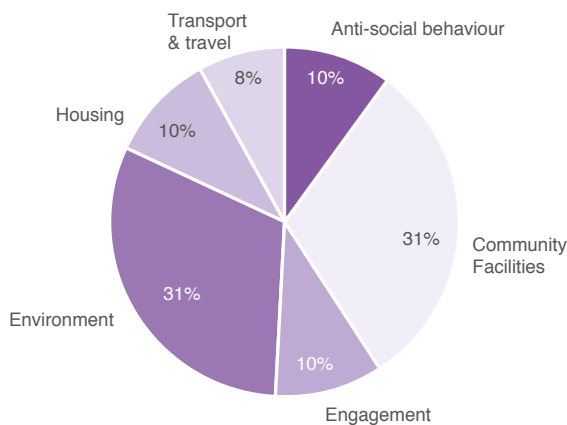
I can take action on environmental issues where I live	46.3%	53.7%	(62.2% • 37.8%)

Some activities like keep fitness units in park like the ones in Finlathan park would be great to get fit.

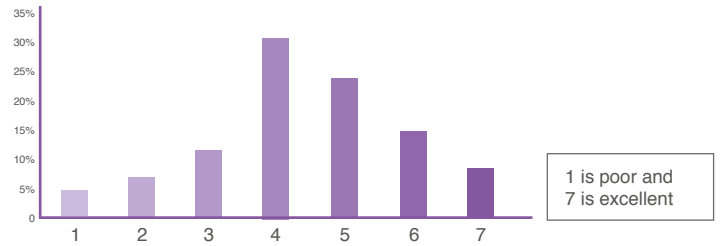
There are no safe crossing areas to get to the park and means crossing a very busy road.

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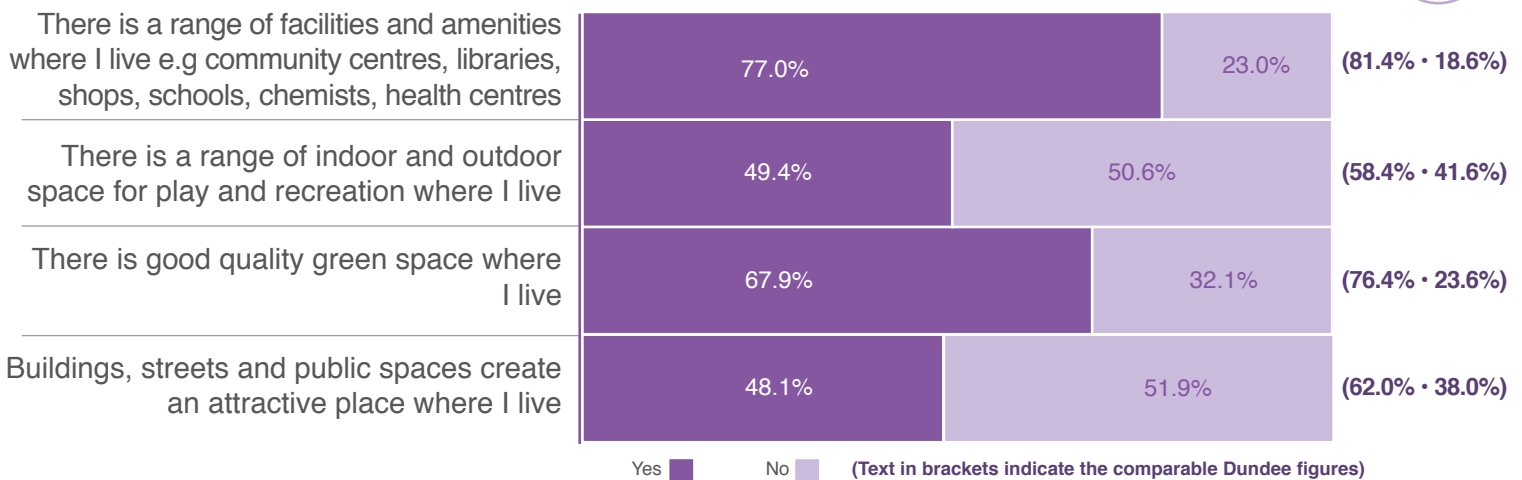
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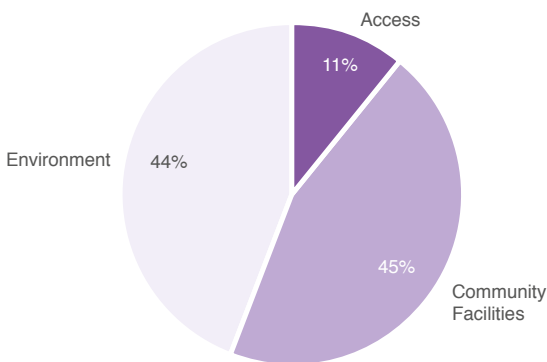
## How you would rate the quality of Community Spaces where you live?

I think if the area was kept cleaner it would be more of a pleasant experience to visit community spaces.

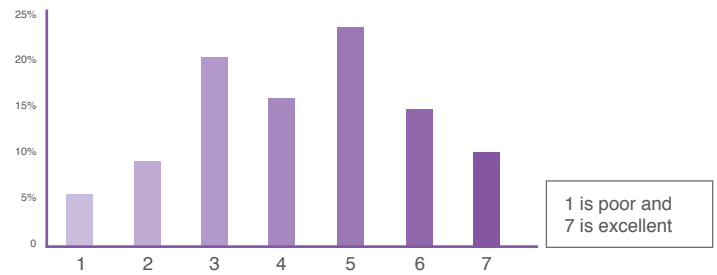
Main cycle/walk routes have lots of over grown branches from very large trees.

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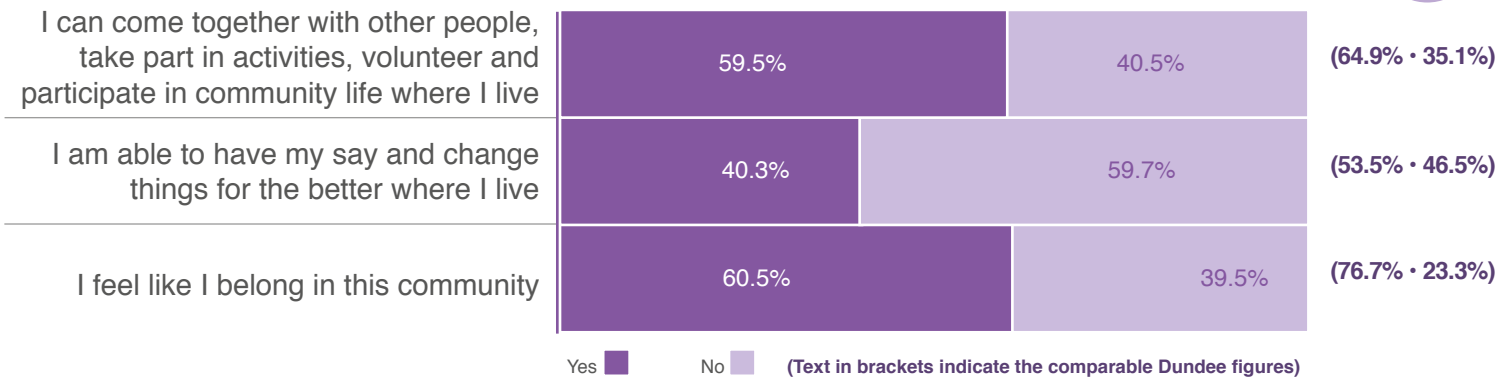
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## How you would rate the quality of Community Spirit where you live?

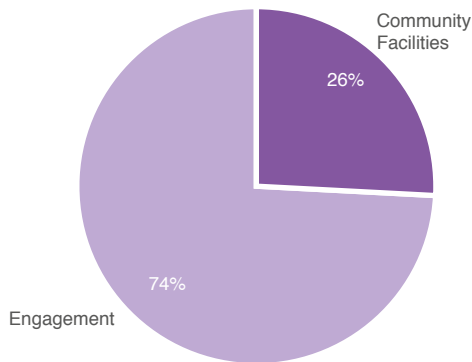

We need to know where our community begins and ends, we can have pride in being the best at things like recycling or keeping litter off our part of the city if we knew what our community was.

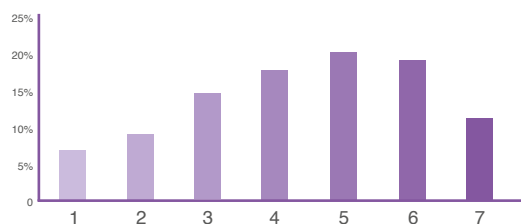
An active Community Council in the area would help make peoples voice heard.

1 is poor and 7 is excellent

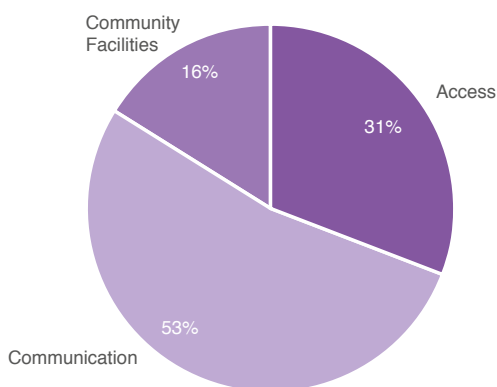

More information on where to access services, making Douglas Medical Centre a proper working Doctors office for everyone in the area.

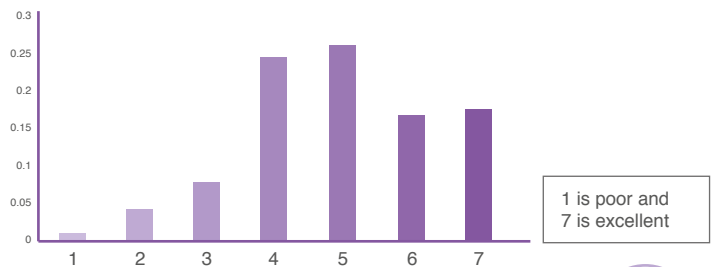
Ensure that the wider community is aware of what support there is and how to access it without the need for internet.

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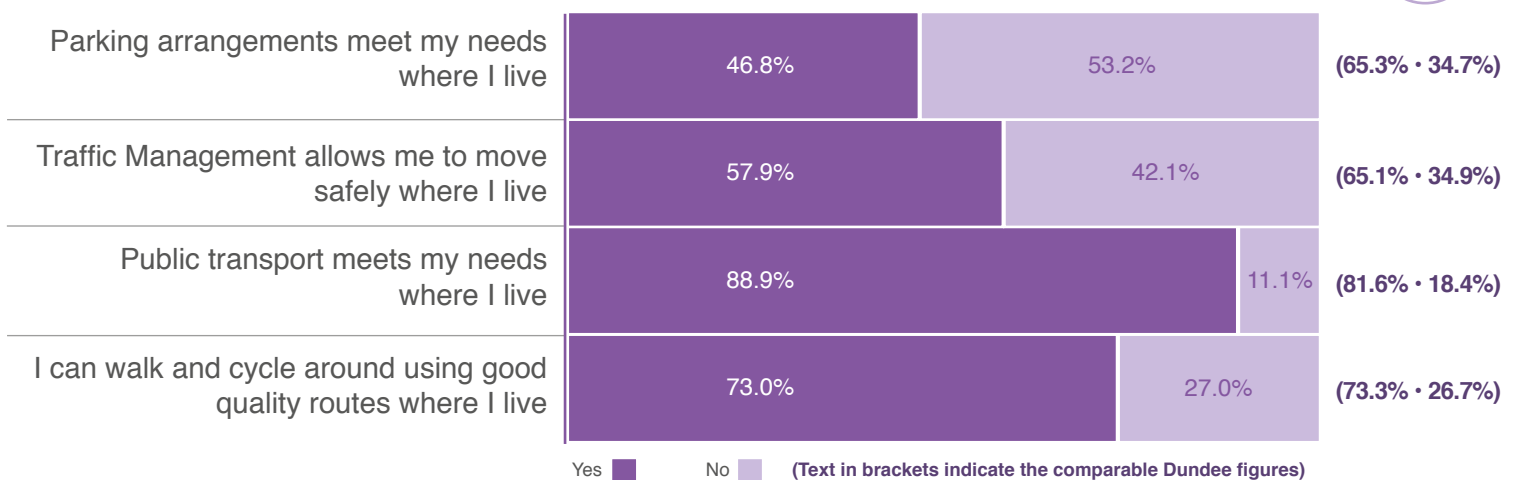
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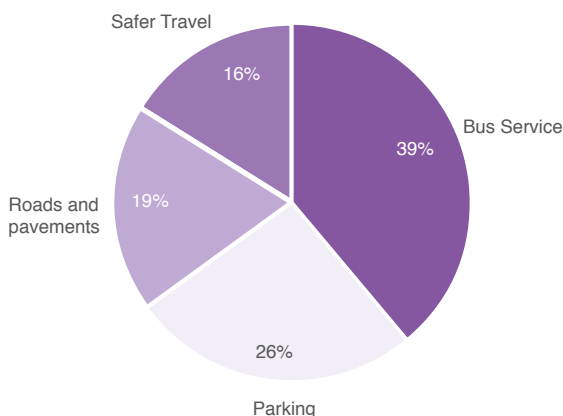
## How you would rate the quality of Community Travel where you live?

## What people said would improve Community Travel.



- There are not enough buses that come my way and there are no buses that go into Tesco area which means we have to walk from Ardler.
- More frequent buses and access to printed timetables easily.
- Too far to walk to nearest bus stop especially when you are infirm or bad on your legs.
- Remove bins from roads and have them on the wide paths.
- Real public transport that serves the community and takes cars off the road, more frequent buses especially in the evening and weekends.
- More parking, bike storage and electric car charging.
- The traffic is so heavy I would feel unsafe cycling a bike on the main roads (Albert street, Dura Street & Arbroath Road), cycle lanes would encourage me to ride.
- Cycle / walking paths would be better if the surrounding grass/weeds were cut to allow people to actually be able to get past each other.
