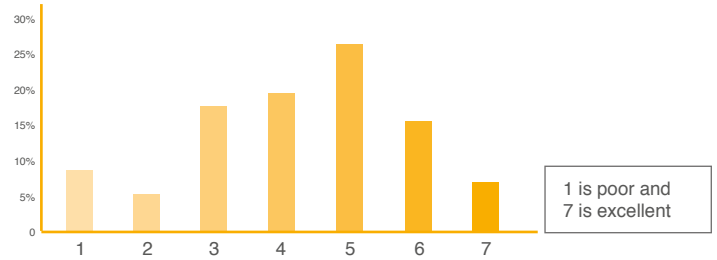

How you would rate the quality of Community Living where you live?



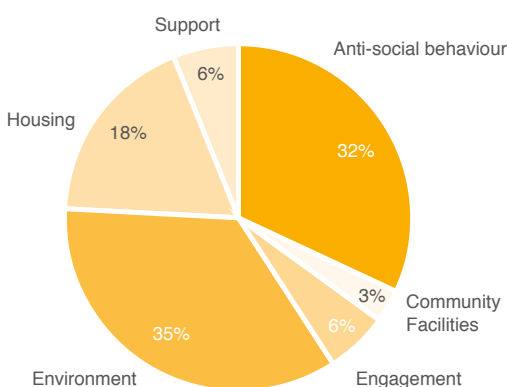

I like the area where I live but feel sad about the number of drug addicts which are being housed and the apparent lack of support for them.

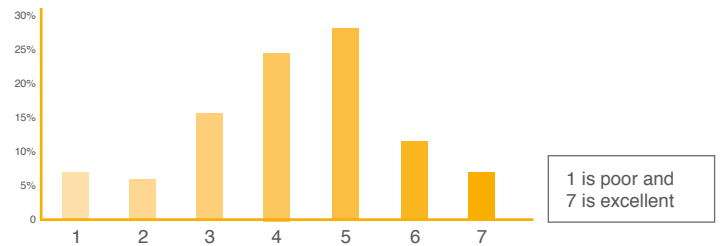
If the drug problem was dealt with more effectively, this has driven families and the elderly away from the High Street.

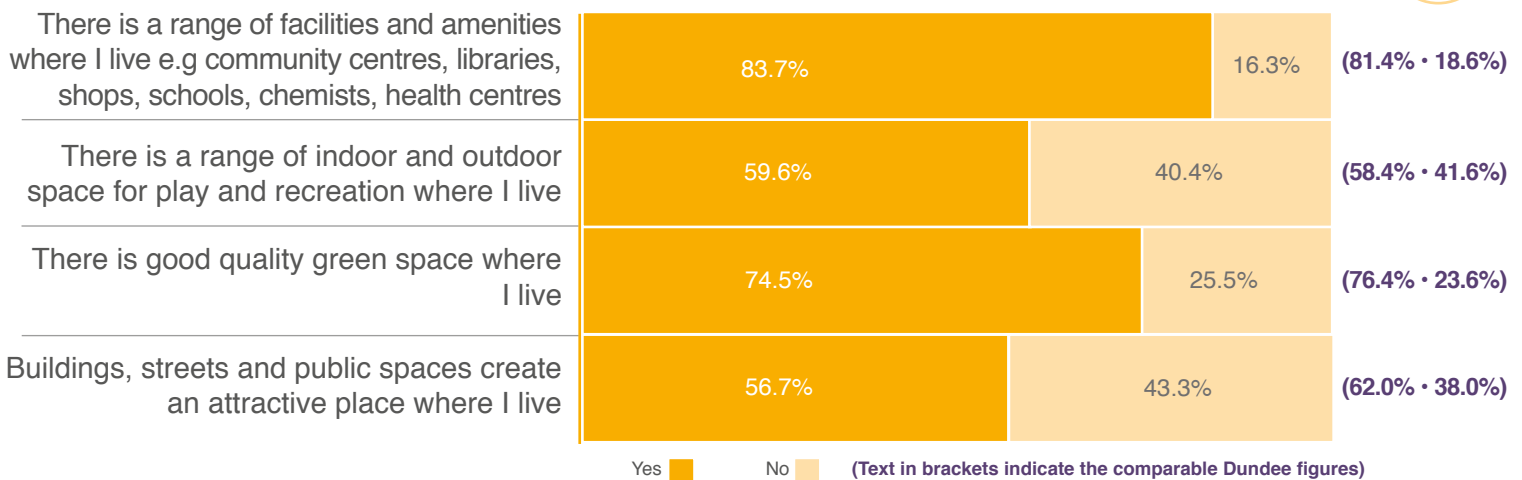

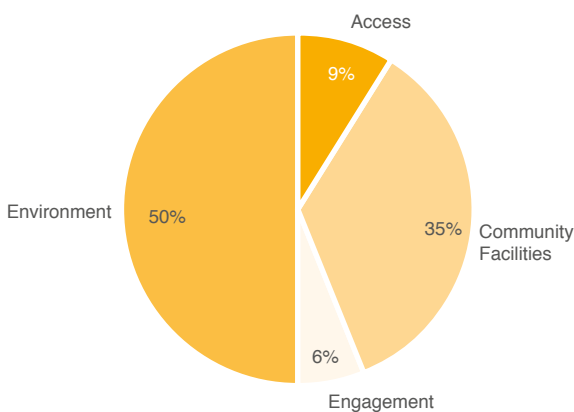
How you would rate the quality of Community Spaces where you live?

Better lighting in green spaces . The new lighting installed is not as bright as it used to be.

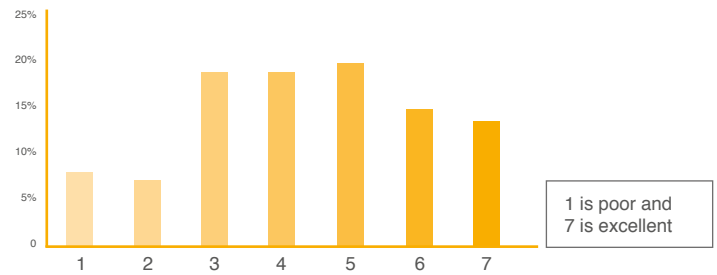
The spare ground to the rear of Gray Street/Perrie Street is an ideal space for children to play but the area is overgrown and untidy.

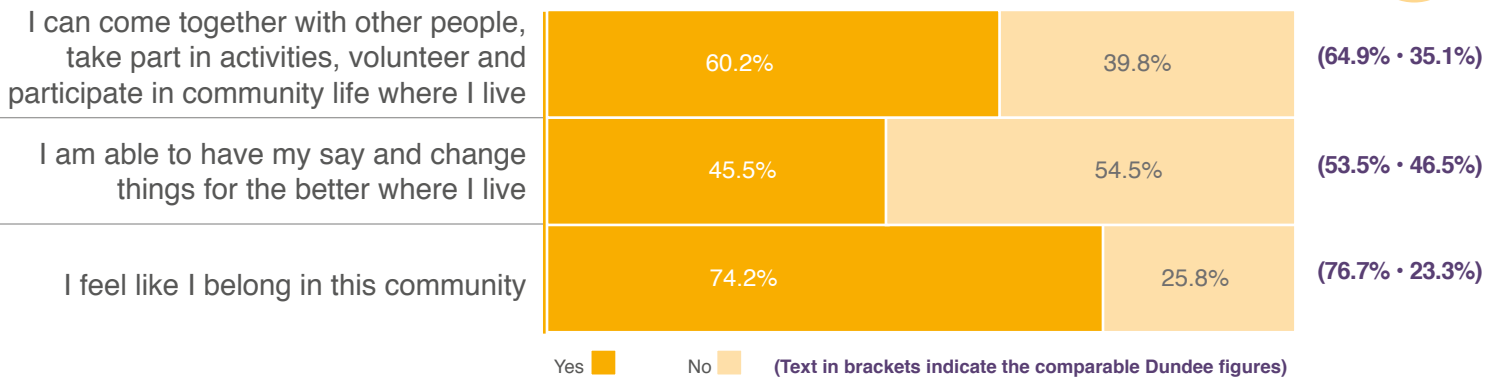

How you would rate the quality of Community Spirit where you live?

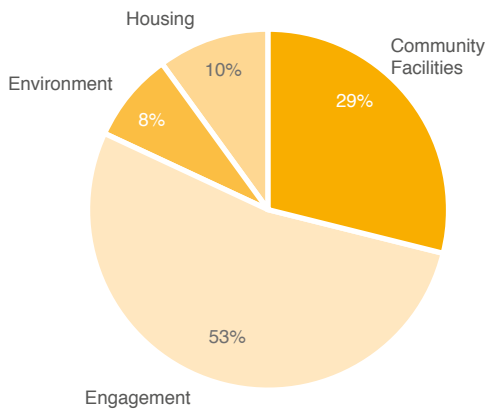

More community profile, there is no obvious opportunities to get involved. Nothing through the door. No community noticeboards. It's the Hub or nothing.

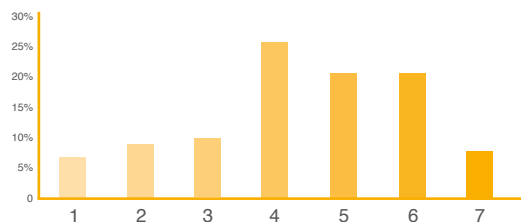
Noticeboards advertising volunteering opportunities

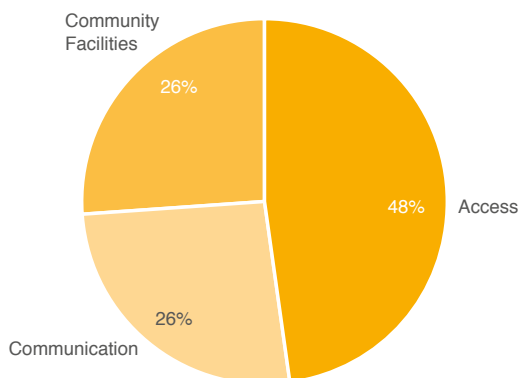

Having somewhere local in Dryburgh to go and talk, it's difficult to walk to Lochee the paths are all uneven, and it's uphill on the way back.

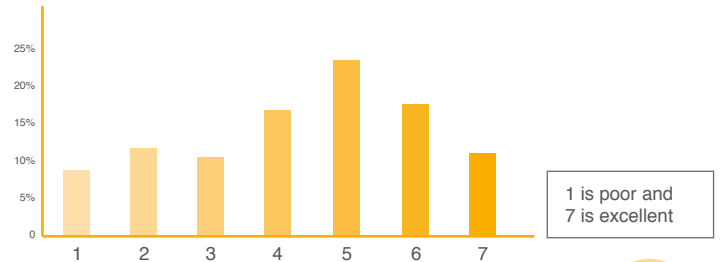
I'd say a lot of the support is given out to the city, not just this area. Local support services would be welcomed.

How you would rate the quality of Community Travel where you live?



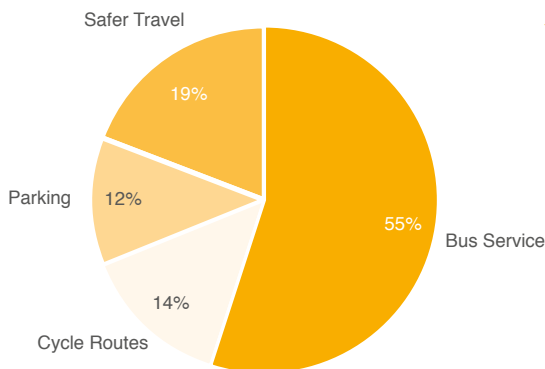
