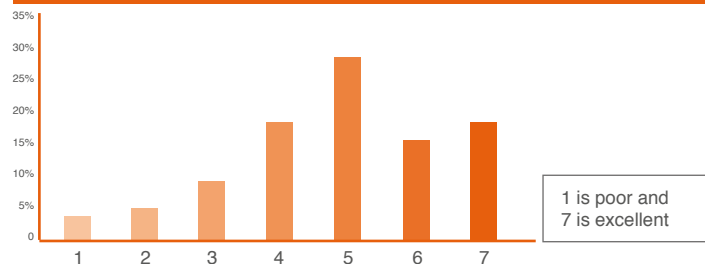


Engage Dundee 2021 was an opportunity for the people of Dundee to tell us about what is important to them. We asked about five aspects of community life in their area; **Community Living, Community Travel, Community Spaces, Community Spirit and Community Support.**

The total respondents across the City was **825** respondents, **76** from North East.

The results below will be used to help inform Local Community Plans, Participatory Budgeting projects and local action across the area.

How you would rate the quality of Community Living where you live?



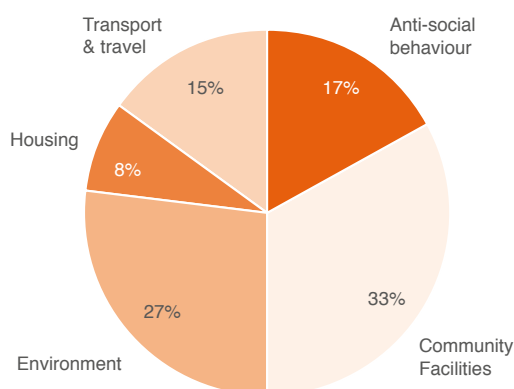
Do you agree with these statements about Community Living in your area?

More thing to do at night for children to get the gangs of them off the streets and causing problems.

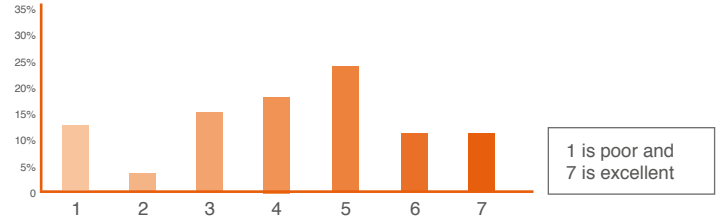
There is no local shop, library, sports facility or secondary school within walking distance the catchment secondary school is an hours walk away.

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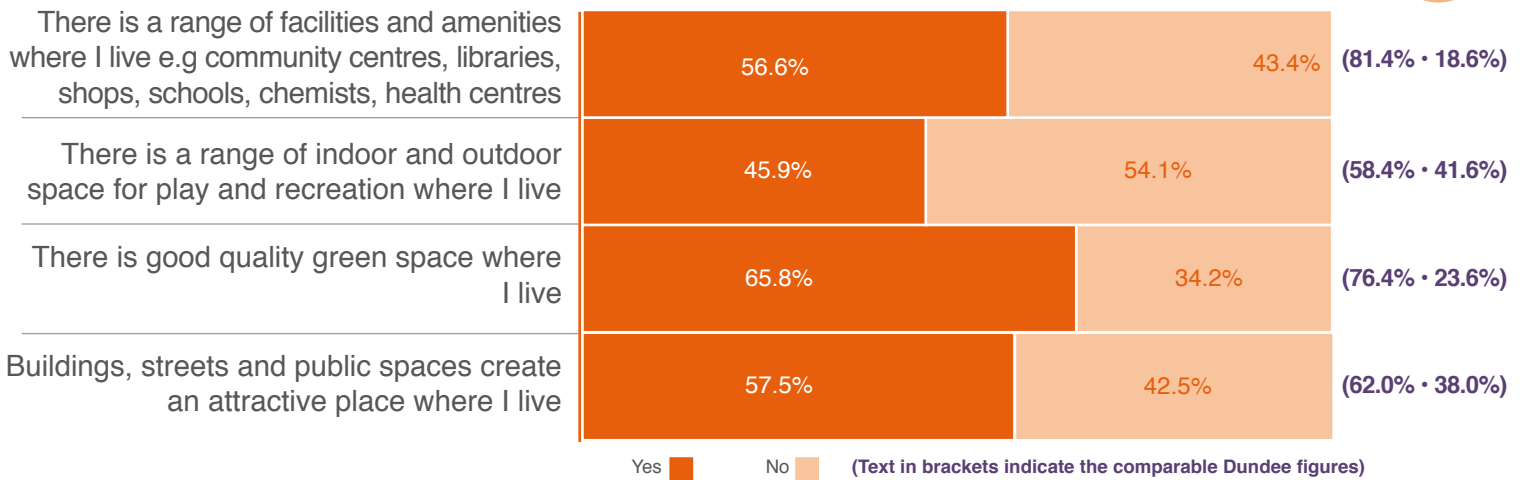
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How you would rate the quality of Community Spaces where you live?



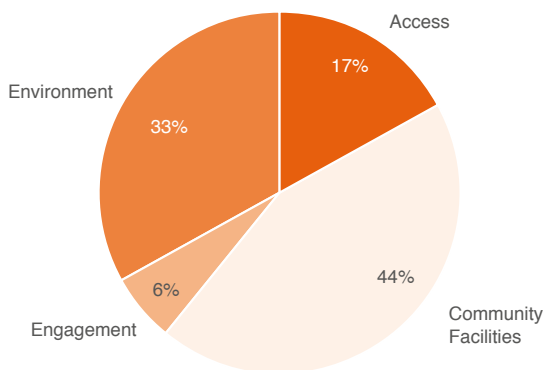
Do you agree with these statements about Community Spaces in your area?

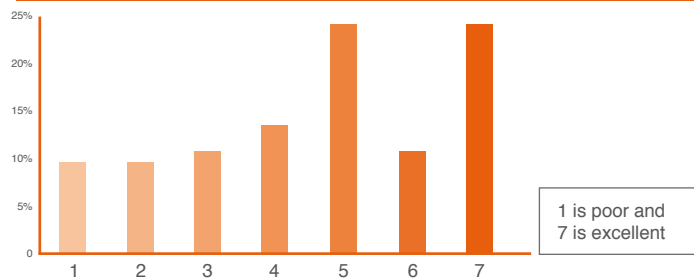
Community Spirit

1 is poor and 7 is excellent

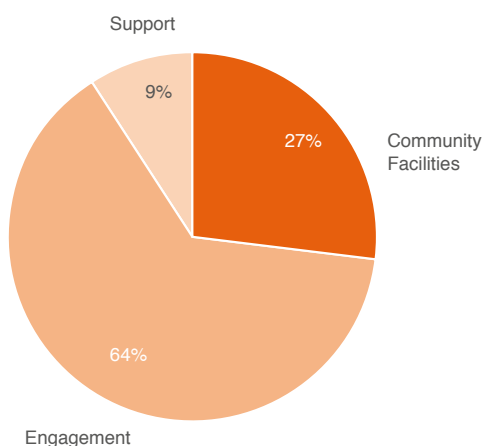
Do you agree with these statements about Community Spirit in your area?

I feel there is no community spirit here now, it is worse with covid, our sheltered housing complex has been closed so there is nowhere to go.

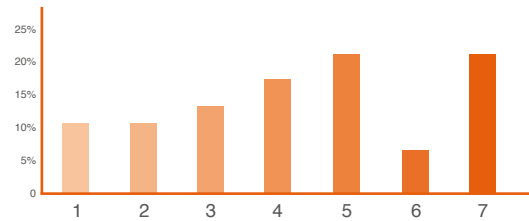
Have places where the public, young people and families can access more support groups and places people can get help and support.

1 is poor and 7 is excellent

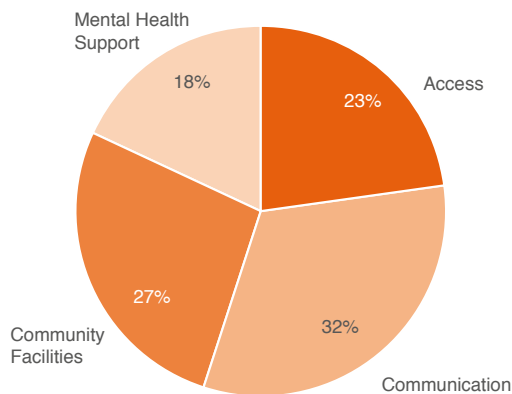

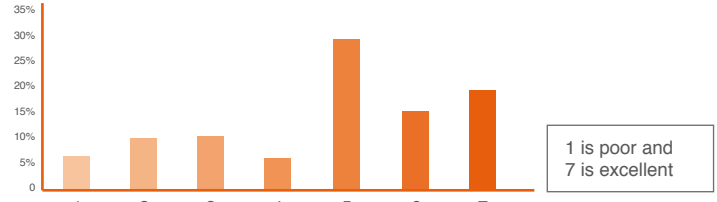
Community Travel

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How you would rate the quality of Community Travel where you live?



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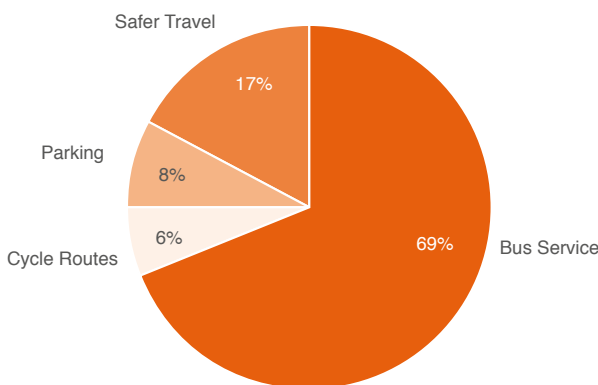
Do you agree with these statements about Community Travel in your area?

- A bus service that is not hourly and also operates at weekends and evenings.
- Better direct bus links to hospital.
- I can access public transport easily enough but it is totally unreliable so I tend to use the car.
- Buses that come into Emmock Woods rather than just to Mill o Mains, it is quite a walk for some local residents.
- Improved quality of cycle routes - better surfaces and less very steep hills.
- Pavements without potholes, more cycle lanes where roller skates can be used.
- Pedestrian crossing from Dalclaverhouse into Caird Park.
