## Flood Risk Management (Scotland) Act 2009 Broughty Ferry Flood Protection Scheme

Please find enclosed copy of a notice to be published on 4 April 2018 advising of a proposed flood protection scheme for Broughty Ferry, Dundee.

The Flood Risk Management (Scotland) Act 2009 imposes a duty on Dundee City Council to exercise its flood risk related functions with a view to reducing overall flood risk. In recognition of this, Dundee City Council is proposing to implement a flood protection scheme to reduce the risk of flooding to residential, open space, community and business properties within Broughty Ferry, through works along Douglas Terrace, James Place, Fisher Street and Beach Crescent, Broughty Ferry.

The potential environmental effects of the proposals and required mitigation measures have been considered throughout the development of the proposals. The proposals have been assessed in accordance with statutory regulations as not requiring an Environmental Impact Assessment but did require preparation of a report to inform the appropriate assessment (RIAA) of the potential effects of the proposals on designated nature conservation areas. Consultees have advised that the RIAA is satisfactory and agree with its conclusions which are that the proposed works should not adversely affect the integrity of these sites and that their conservation objectives will continue to be met during and after development.




