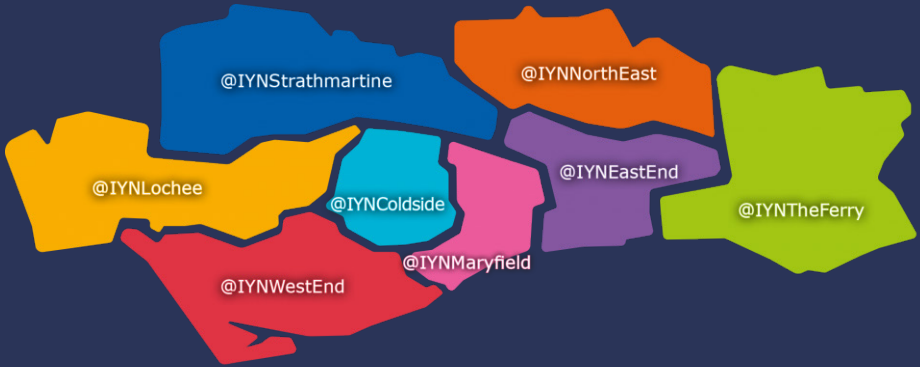

<b>We need to tackle social isolation and improve mental wellbeing</b>	Family groups, children, young and older people have said they feel isolated and their mental health has been affected, particularly during lockdown periods. <b>We need to improve local supports for people in recovery and their families</b>	Menziesshill residents who are in recovery have said they would not access services in central Lochee or the city centre.  Residents have said they have noticed an apparent lack of support for some people who struggle with their substance use in and around central Lochee.	Create an engagement programme and activities that meet the needs of those in recovery living in Menziesshill.  Develop an outreach programme in central Lochee for those who have no access to services.	Health & Wellbeing
<b>We need quality green and open spaces that people can access in their own communities</b>	Residents talk of how important green and open space is to them for their own, and their community's health and well-being.
