

How to use the Blether Bus

The Blether Bus is a hail and ride service. This means that as well as being able to board the minibus at any of the bus stops along the route, the driver will also pick up and drop off from streets where there are no bus stops.

Wait at a safe place where the minibus can pull into the side of the road and wave to the driver when the bus appears. Once on board, just tell the driver where you want to get off. Booking is not required, just hail the bus and come aboard.

Members Only

The Blether Bus has been designed for people who find it difficult to use local bus services.

You must become a member to use the Blether Bus – but joining up is quick and easy and can be done on the first day you decide to travel. You will be given a Blether Bus membership card on your first trip.

Write your name on the card and keep it safe next to your bus pass. There is no joining fee and no need for ID.

Show the membership card and your bus pass to the driver each time you use the minibus.

Who runs the Blether Bus?

The Blether Bus will be operated with Council minibuses and driven by a friendly and welcoming team of drivers.

They'll be happy to chat with you and we hope you will also have a blether with other passengers. You can use the bus even if it's just to get out of the house for a ride around your local community.

The Blether Bus can also be used for very short journeys so don't worry about inconveniencing anyone. That's exactly what this service is for.

How much does it cost?

You don't pay a fare to use the Blether Bus but you should carry your membership card and bus pass when you travel.

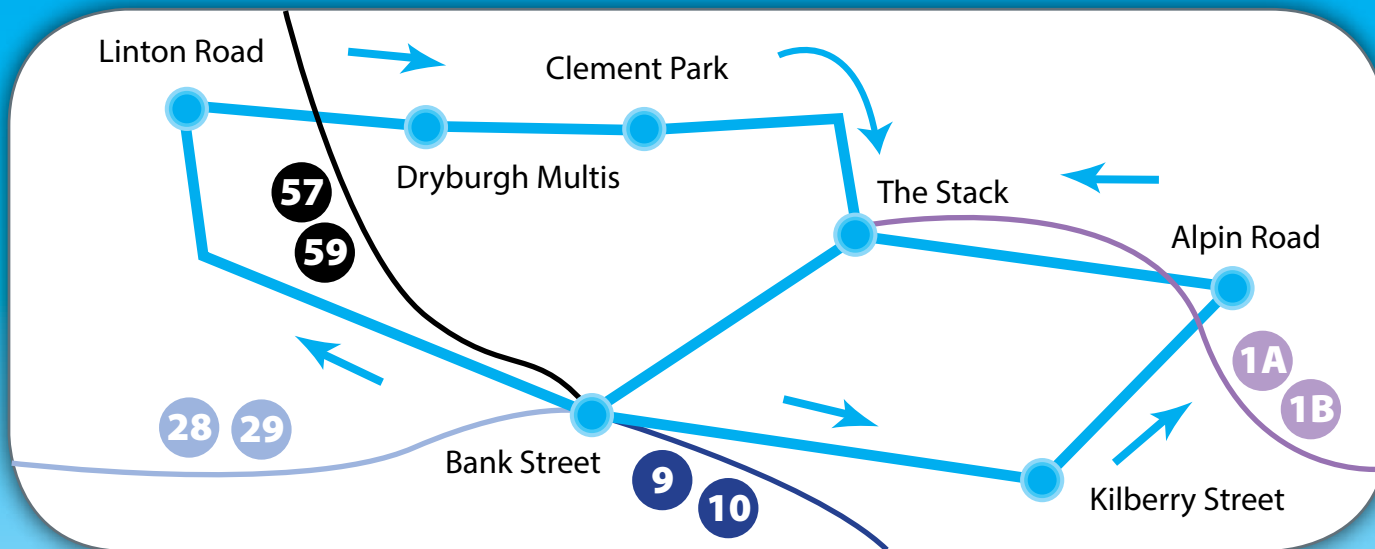
