



Each community has its own characteristics with Finty being the oldest area after its first buildings were developed in the late 1940s. Following this, Dalclaverhouse in the 1960s and Whitfield/ Mill O' Mains in the late 1960s/early 1970s were built in an open plan style, a lot of which has been redeveloped over the last decade, which also saw the construction of the newest areas of Ballumbie and Emmock Woods.

The ward is very rural in nature with the Dighty Valley providing a linear park along the southern boundary and the countryside forming a northerly boundary creating a built corridor of housing in between.

The ward is comprised of the communities of Ballumbie, Dalclaverhouse, Emmock Woods, Finty, Mill O' Mains and Whitfield. These communities have many facilities which include several nurseries, 5 primary schools, Braeview Academy, Fimill Centre, Finty Library and the Crescent in Whitfield (an integrated City Council and NHS facility). The voluntary sector also manage community facilities in the Ormiston Lounge, Families House (in Grampian Gardens) and the Mill O' Mains Pavilion.

The North East Ward has a population of over 17,000 people. It is bound by the Dighty Burn to the south, Trottick Ponds to the west and the Kellas Road to the east. The City Council boundary provides the northern extremity of the ward.

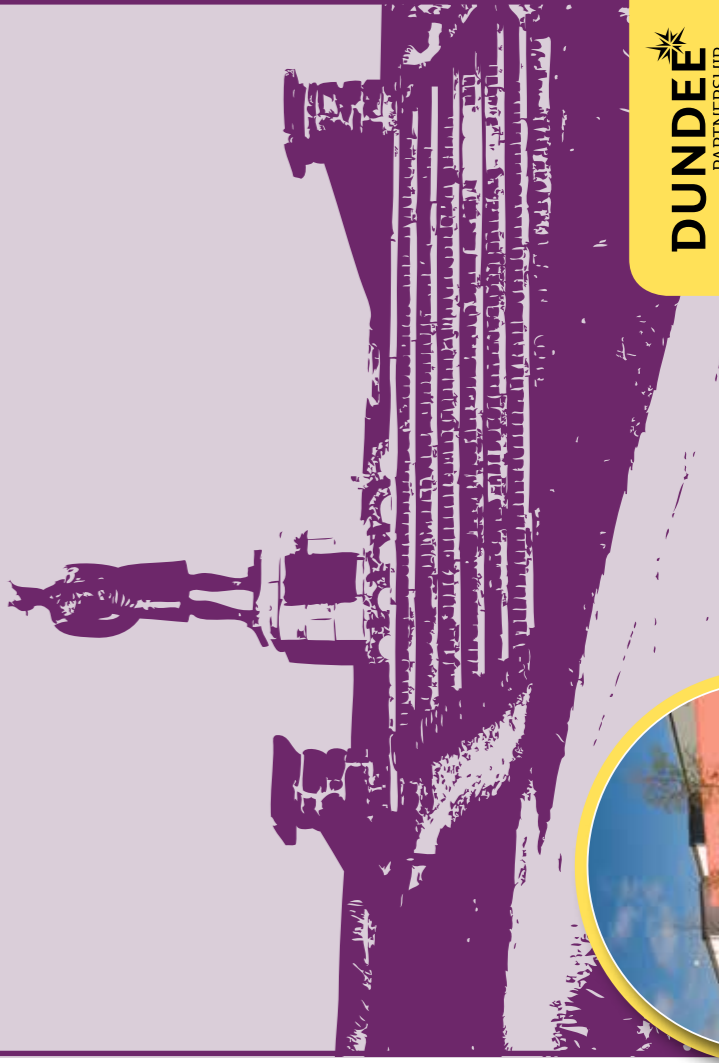

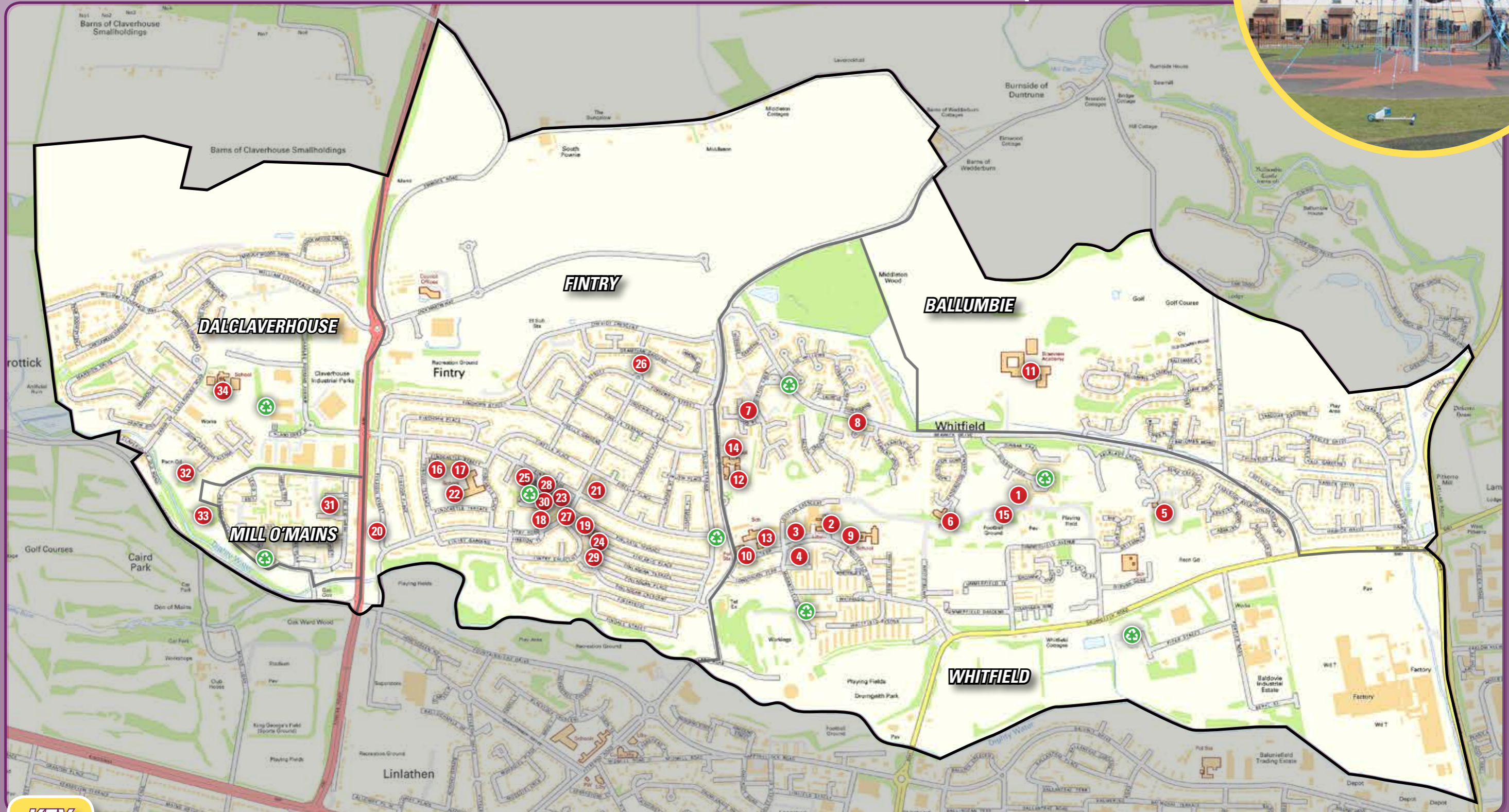
