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## INTRODUCTION

Volume 8A of the Town Council Minutes opens in the Spring of 1716. The previous volume ceased abruptly on 1st August 1715, when the country was in a state of upheaval during the Rebellion of 1715.

Normally the councillors and magistrates were elected at Michaelmas, however, because of the unrest, no elections were held that September. In February 1716 a temporary magistracy was appointed by the Duke of Argyll, and in March a special Warrant was issued by George I, empowering the Duke of Douglas, Alexander Duncan of Lundie, David Halyburton of Pitcur, John Scrymgeour of Tealing, and John Scrymgeour, jun. of Tealing, to proceed with the election of councillors and magistrates, which they did on 26th April 1716. In September 1716 another election was held, thus bringing Dundee back into line with the customary practice of holding annual elections at Michaelmas.

The following index therefore, covers a period of 18 months, i.e. from April 1716 to September 1717, and includes the elections held in April 1716 and September 1716. The manner of identifying entries in the Council Minutes is dictated by the fact that pages of the Minutes Book are not numbered. Identification is by the date of the minute in which the entry can be found. Spelling of proper names was not consistent within these minutes, and for the purpose of the index the practice was adopted of using the modern equivalent with variations shown in parenthesis.

As a number of the terms used in the index are no longer in common usage a limited glossary has been provided below.
