ROUTE DESCRIPTION

From the car park, ao down the South Drive from the entrance to the Wildlife Centre, and turn right at the bottom, following the blue waymarks. This track follows the inside of the perimeter wall of Camperdown Park, climbing up to the derelict West Lodge. Cross the West Drive keeping to the left of the artificial turf of the golfers path. The path joins the Green Circular for a while and climbs past the old Game Keepers cottage, and swings to the right for a long descent over the North Drive to the Main Drive. Cross the Main Drive, keeping the wood to the left, for a quick descent around the edge of football pitches, to Laburnum Walk at the north of the play area. Keep the play area on your left to return to the car park.

Camperdown Park has other shorter waymarked trails and links to Templeton Woods and Clatto Park by the Green Circular.

One thing that helps make Dundee's green spaces great for mountain biking is Scotland's much respected access legislation. Here's some advice from the Scottish Outdoor Access Code:

- Take responsibility for your own actions.
- Respect people's privacy and peace of mind.
- Help land managers and other work safely and effectively.
- Care for your environment. Do not disturb wildlife, leave the environment as you find it and follow the path or track.

We also ask:

- Keep off fragile tracks if they are wet and liable to erosion. try to stick to the line of the path.
- Please do vour bit to keep our areen spaces areat
- Be prepared to stop for other path users.

Route Specifics

- There are several roads to cross. Please be cautious. and do not assume that drivers stick to the 10mph limit in the park.
- The park is popular for dog walking and family walks. Dogs and children do not have to be on leads. Be prepared to stop, and take care on descents
