DUNDEE CITY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

<u>DUNDEE CITY COUNCIL (CASTLE STREET AND CRICHTON STREET, DUNDEE)</u> (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LOADING) ORDER 2021

Dundee City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "Dundee City Council (Castle Street and Crichton Street, Dundee) (Temporary Prohibition of Waiting and Loading) Order 2021" and shall come into effect on the Seventeenth day of February Two Thousand and Twenty One.
- Save as provided in Articles 4 and 6 hereof no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the west side of Crichton Street for its entire length from its junction with High Street to its junction with Whitehall Crescent, Dundee.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 hereof no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on either side of Castle Street for its entire length.
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified in that Article for so long as may be necessary to enable a person who is attending the Mass Vaccination Centre situated at Caird Hall, Dundee to board or alight from the vehicle.
- 5. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified in that Article if the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle which is not causing an obstruction and which is displaying in the relevant position a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority in exercise of its powers under Section 21(1) of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons' Act 1970.
- 6. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to wait in the length of road specified in those Articles if the vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated in or adjacent to that length of road;
 - (b) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in sub paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (c) for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or in the service of a local authority in pursuance of statutory powers and duties.
