What is the role of Housing Support Officer

To provide support to tenants to help them manage their tenancy. This support will reduce the risk of eviction, anti-social behaviour, debt and other risks to people's homes.

Tenants may be receiving voluntary support or may be conditional and related to a Short Scottish Secure Tenancy.

Support may also be provided to prospective tenants to help them gain access to accommodation which best meets their needs and wants.
