What is the role of Housing Support Officer

The Housing Support team is a voluntary service which is free and confidential. It is available to tenants of Dundee City Council. We offer advice and assistance to help people manage and sustain their tenancies and live independently. Support will be provided for as long as you need it, up to a maximum of 2 years.

The team are registered with the Care Inspectorate and operate in accordance with the National Care Standards. We also work in line with the values contained in the Scottish Social Services Council's codes of practice for social service workers.
